CALL FOR PAPERS

A Research Competition and a Clinical Case Competition is open, with a **poster presentation** that will be held during the Symposium.

Abstracts can only be submitted in **English.**

It is possible to be present in more than one abstract (maximum 6 authors), even as I^{st} Author. However, each Author can only be the lead presenter in no more than one abstract for each competition.

Deadline for abstract submissions is <u>March the 20th 2023</u>. Please note that late submissions will not be considered.

The Organizing Secretariat (MJ Eventi) shall submit the abstracts, to the Scientific Commission for their assessment.

The Lead Presenter must register and remit the registration fee for the Symposium in order to publish the abstract on the final program and on *Journal of Osseointegration (ed. ARIESDUE - indexed on Scopus)*.

To compete for the award, all lead presenters shall be available near the poster during lunch break on Friday May the 26th.

The best Research selected by the Scientific Commission will be awarded the Antony H. Melcher Prize of \in 1.000.

The best Clinical Case selected by the Scientific Commission will be awarded the Antony H. Melcher Prize of \in 1.000.

Guidelines for Abstract submission

- Research Competition

The contribution shall concern Clinical research in all fields related to Periodontology or Implantology.

Please use the suitable <u>electronic form</u> and submit it dividing the contribution into:

Aim; Materials and Methods; Results; Conclusions.

Aim - Max. 500 characters, including blanks Methods - Max. 1500 characters, including blanks Results - Max. 1500 characters, including blanks Conclusions - Max. 1000 characters, including blanks

Figures and tables (up to a maximum of 7) can be inserted and must be described.

Evaluation criteria are: Originality of the hypothesis, study design, methodology, scientific and clinical relevance.

- Clinical Case Competition

The contribution shall concern Clinical Case related to Periodontal or Peri-implant Soft Tissue Management (in the field of Periodontology, Implantology, Prosthodontic or Restorative Dentistry).

Please use the suitable electronic form and submit it dividing the contribution into:

Background; Case report; Conclusions.

Background - Max. 500 characters, including blanks Case report - Max. 1500 characters, including blanks Conclusions - Max. 1000 characters, including blanks

- a minimum of 6 to a maximum of 18 high resolution TIF or JPEG images (minimum resolution 300 dpi, 6x9cm print format).

- a brief caption of the images.

The Clinical and Radiographic documentation shall include the main treatment dates.

Evaluation criteria are: Case documentation, rational for treatment, clinical results.
